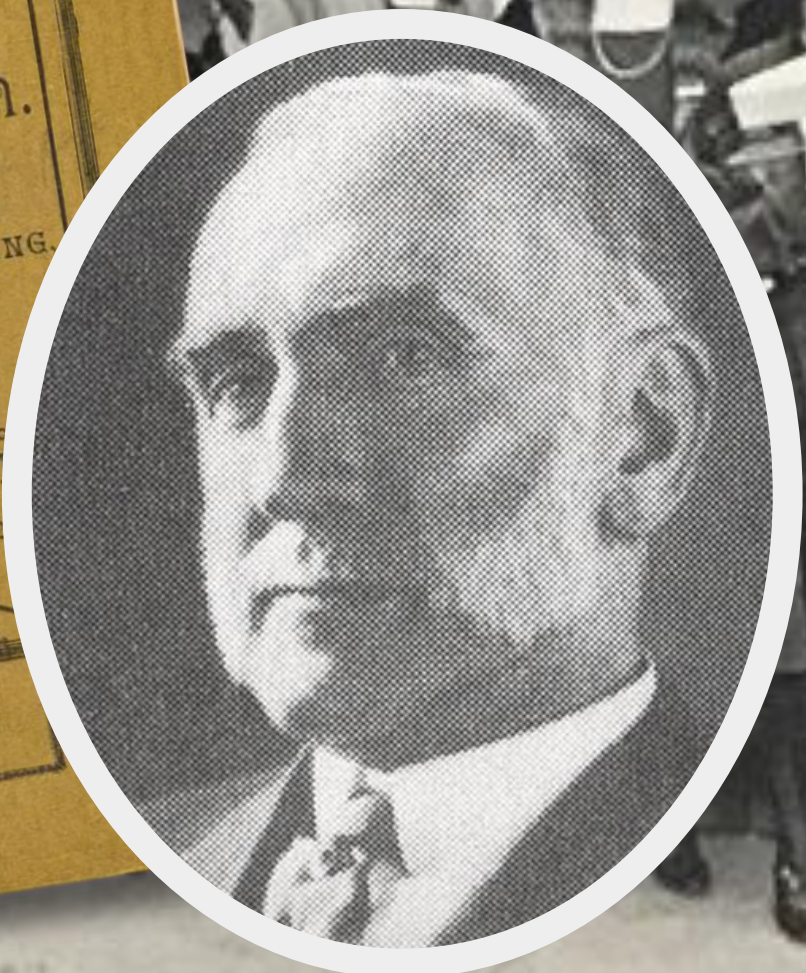
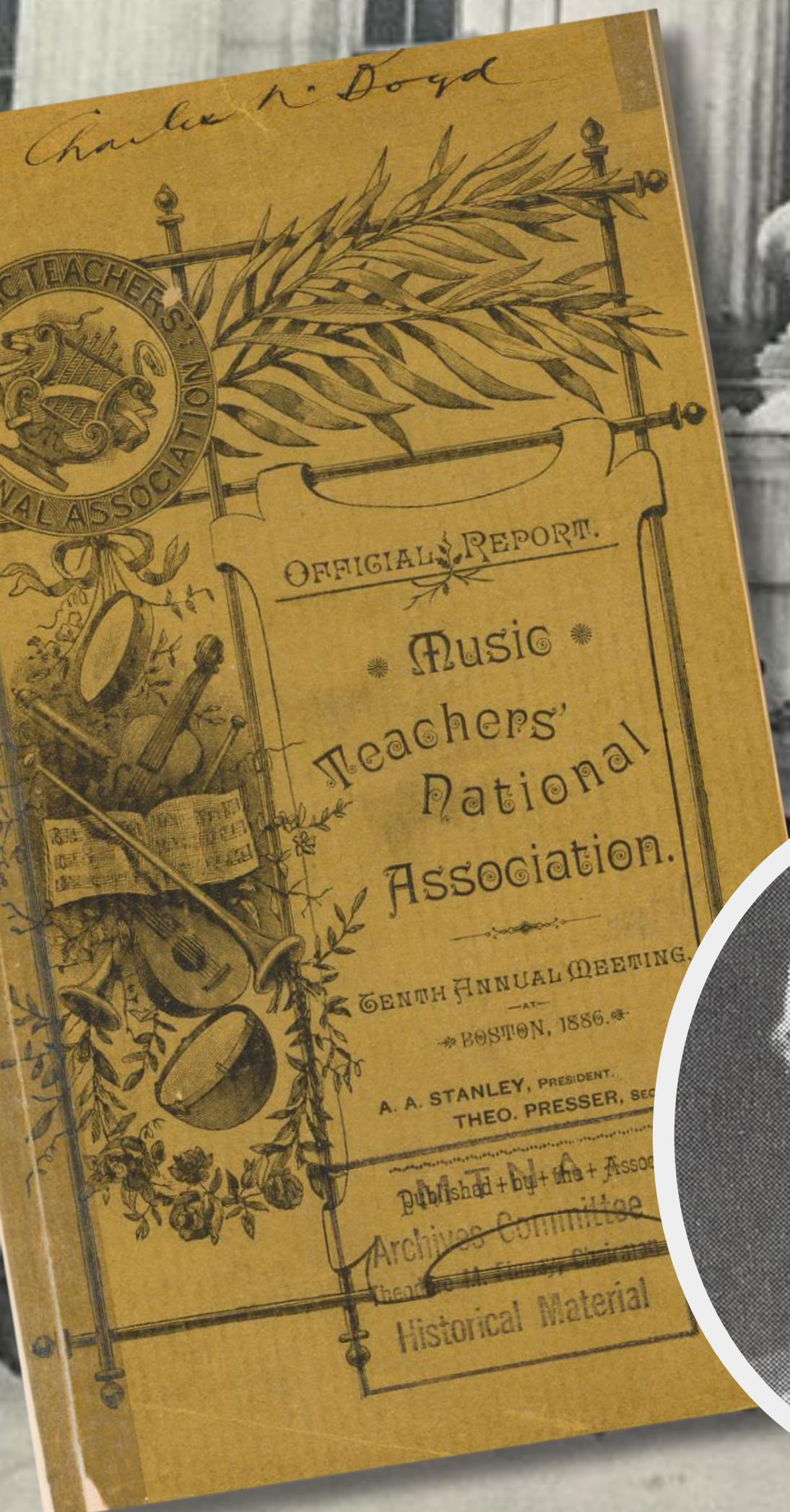

MTNA President Ruth Edwards presided over a successful Kansas City convention.

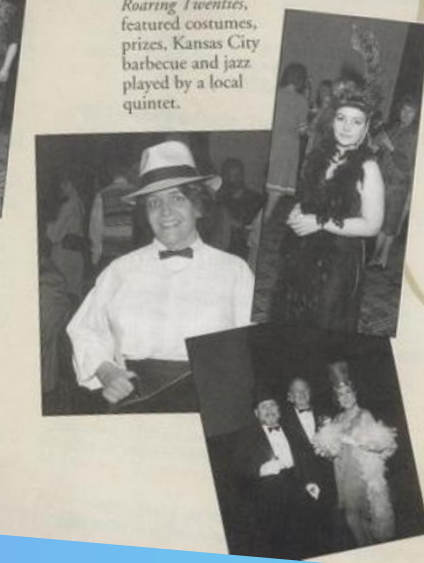


The Technology In Music Symposium offered learning for young and old. Andrea Stennett, a symposium clinician, answers a convention-goer's questions.

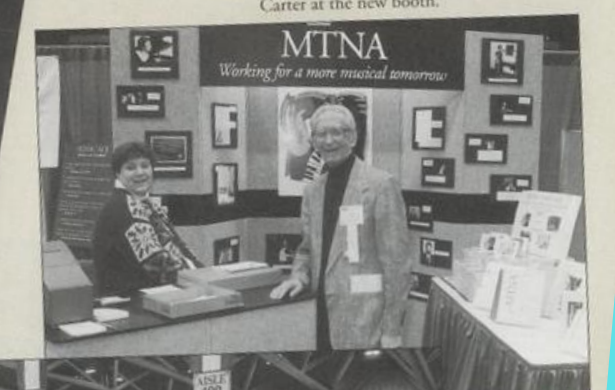

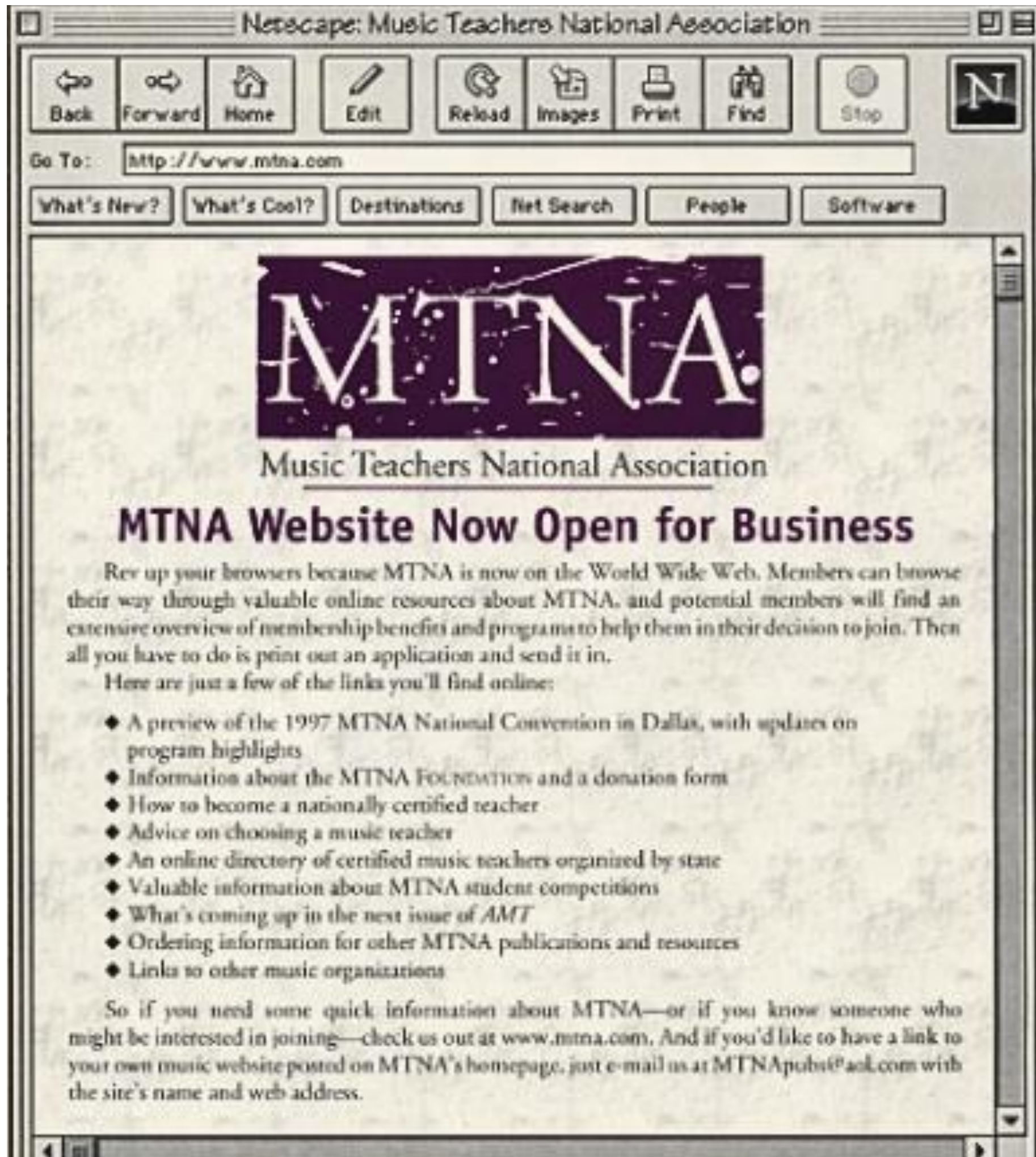

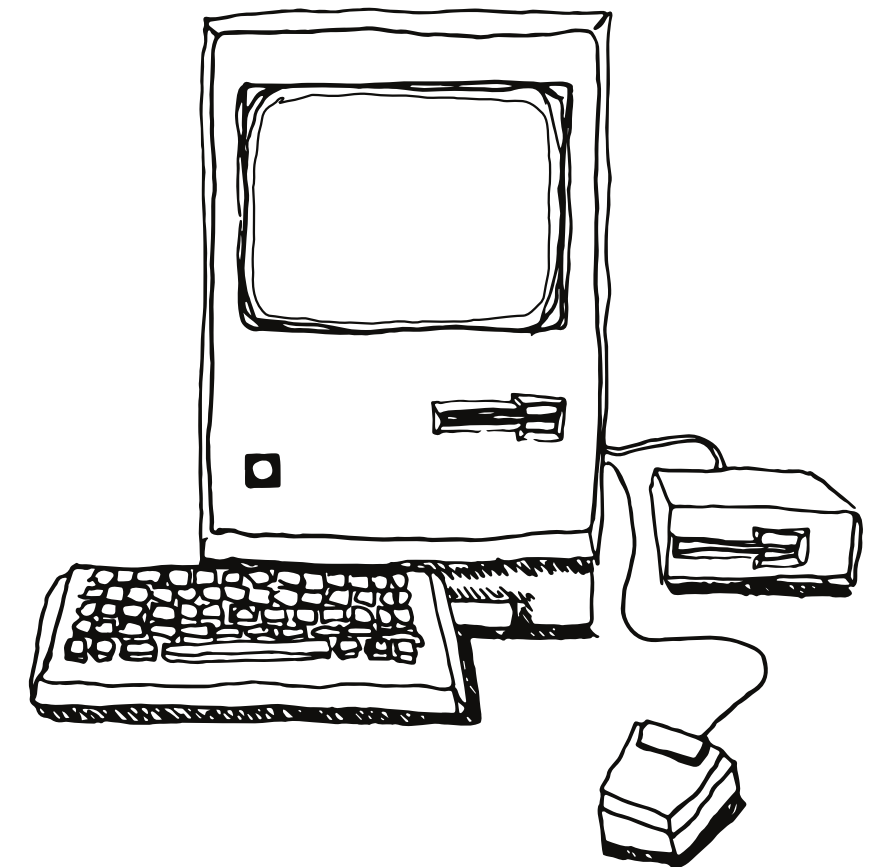
