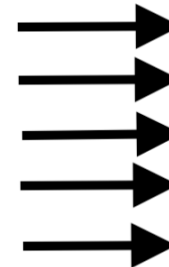

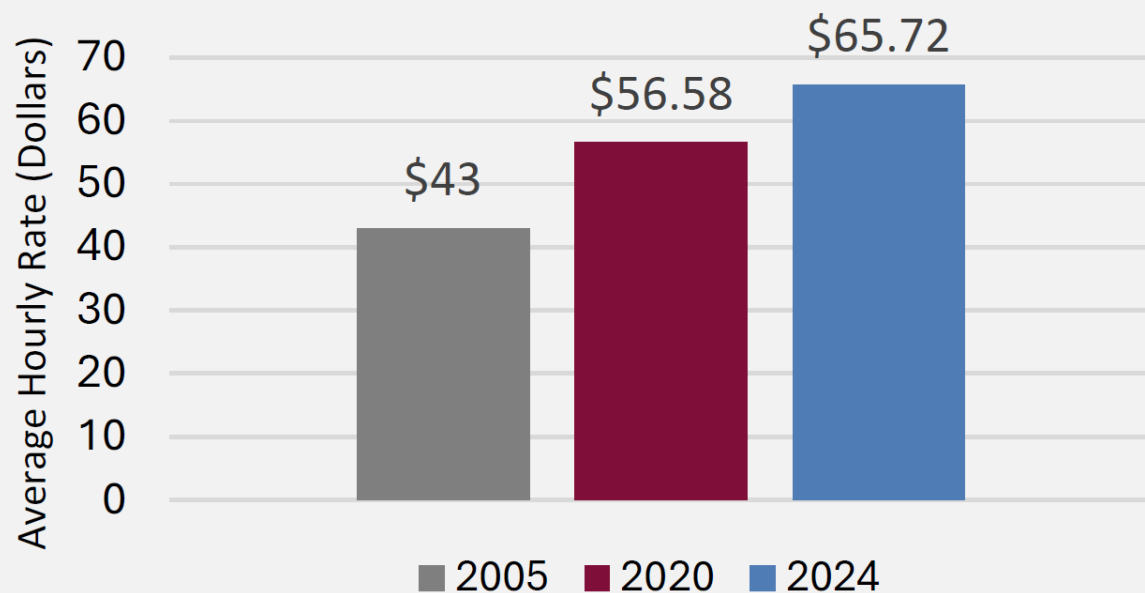

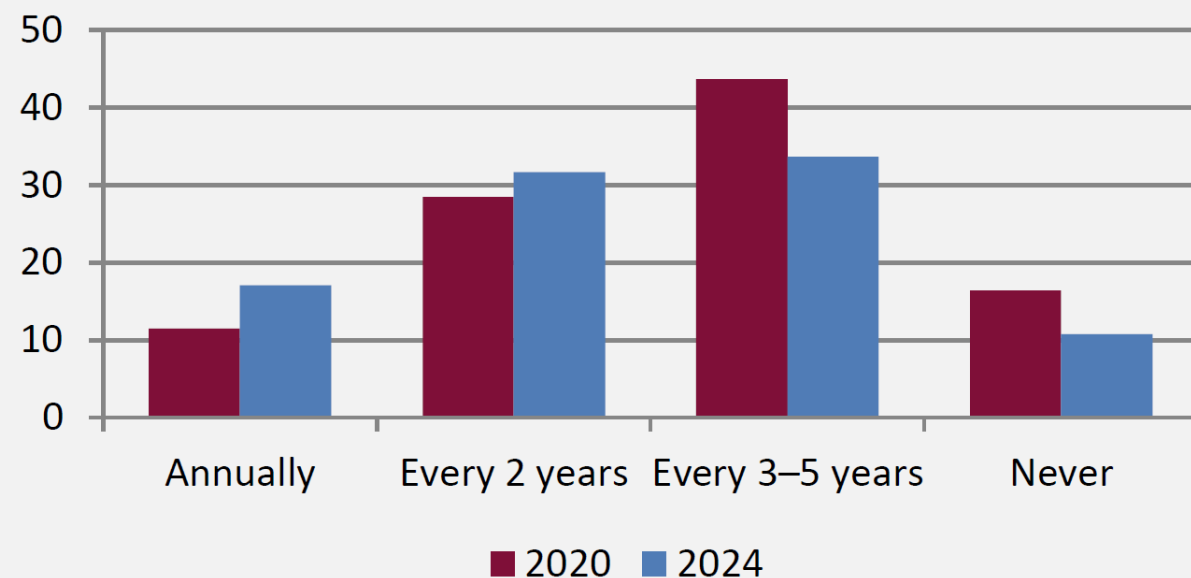

How Often Teachers Raise their Rates

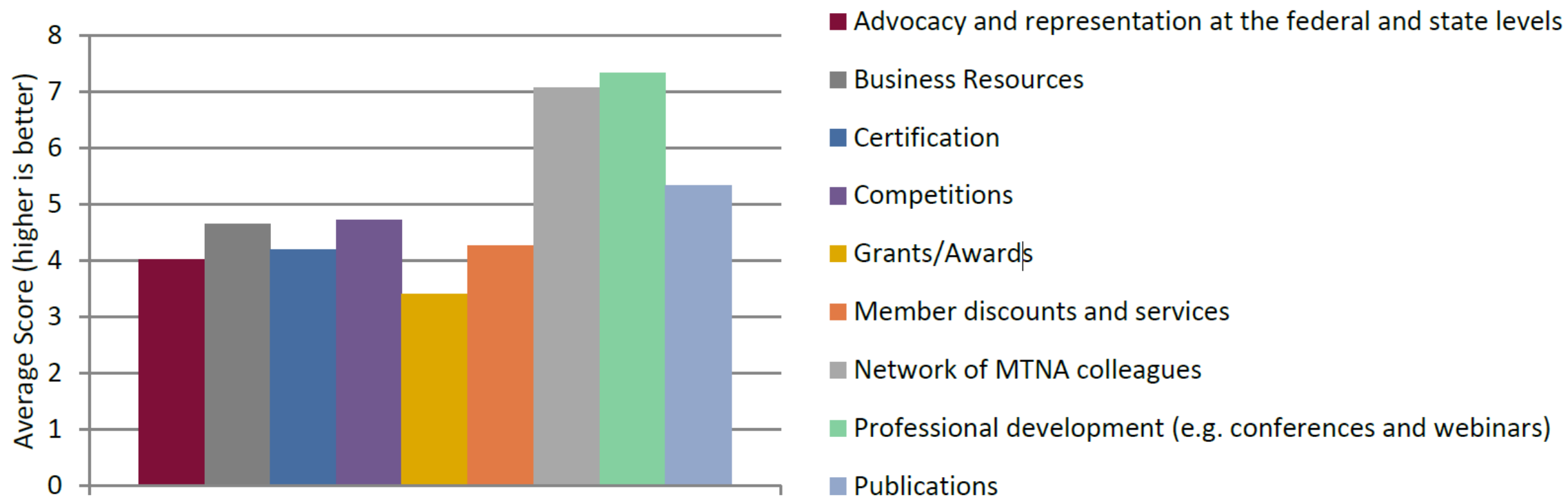

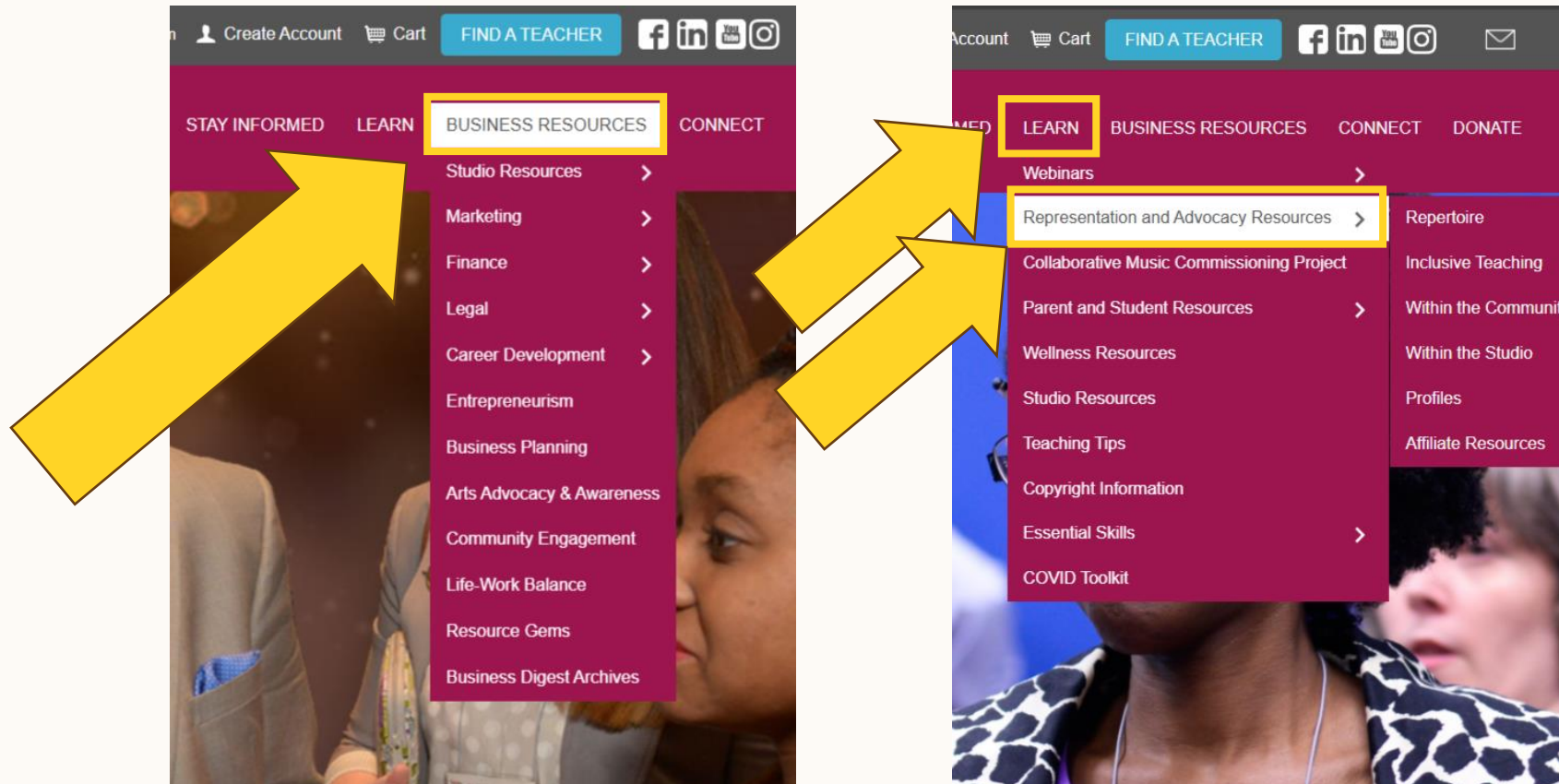
